Rolling terrain, varied soils and climate combine to create exquisite growing conditions for exceptional fruit used to make award winning wine. At Robert Hall, we capture the essence of Paso Robles in every bottle.

VINTAGE NOTES

The Syrah is from Creston and Margarita Ranch Districts as well as our Bench Vineyard just off the Tasting Room Terrace (Estate). The Grenache come from the Adelaida District. The Petite Sirah comes from our Monahan Ranch (Estate) and the Brady Vineyard.

WINEMAKING

Syrah is sourced from cooler areas to help preserve fruit flavors and spice. This wine was aged in French and Eastern European Oak for 18 months.

TASTING NOTES

The 2016 vintage began with below average rainfall as the Paso Robles area continues to be effected by drought. The dry start was followed by above average warm temperatures that lasted through June, at which point temperatures became more moderate. While harvest came early to many in Paso Robles, the mild temperatures extended our growing season improving overall grape quality
