- FACILITIES** { Located in the heart of California's Central Valley, our Parlier winery and distillery near Fresno has enjoyed a proud tradition of processing brandy and varietal wines since 1900. As a result of a robust capital improvement plan, O'Neill Vintners has been able to make significant infrastructure and equipment upgrades that have transformed our Parlier facility into one of the most modern wineries in California. The facility features a crush capacity of 155,000 tons and 36 million gallons of stainless steel, temperature controlled cooperage.

He began his winemaking career in 1977 with Pacific Land and Viticulture and later moved to Sebastiani in 1982, where he became Director of Winemaking. In 1986 Rasmussen started his own company, Global Vin and Beverage, where he was instrumental in the launch of both the Vinterra and Viansa wine brands. He holds an undergraduate degree from UC Berkeley and a graduate degree in Food Science/Enology from Fresno State University.
