- Assist with winery trials and data collection
- Assist with cellar operations- including cap management, inoculations, and additions
- Interface between winemakers, cellar staff and lab
- Assist with work orders and the updating on winemaking documents
- Monitor barrel fermentation
- Monitor Micro-Ox Tanks
- Other projects and duties as assigned
